




Project Planning – All because of an acorn.

To identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense


Look at the skeleton and label the main bones.



To observe changes across the four seasons


To observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.

To look at the weather and discuss changes within the seasons. Allocate months to seasons.




To find out how the seasons affect animals.

Look at hibernation and food supply. Look at the robin and what he eats in winter.




To look at how the seasons affect humans.

To look at what fruits and vegetables are available in the different seasons and which are flown in. Discuss daylight hours and how this affects what we do in the evenings.



To identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat.

To make pumpkin soup with some autumn vegetables.



To be able to name the 5 senses.
To identify the different teeth a human has.

To identify and label the different receptors on the tongue.
