Key question - How do archaeologists gather information about the past?

STONE AGE • SUPERB STAI

- **SUPERB STARTER** Virtual museum tour and Cave paintings on fabrics using natural materials.
- Introduce vocab & theme of prehistory 3 stone age periods Paleolithic Period, Mesolithic Period and Neolithic Period.
- Stone Age Life hunter gatherer, farming, fishing, weapons, shelter, food and nutrition, animals, religion, beliefs.
- Cooking and nutrition Prepare foods, look at healthy diet and digestion; did they have a balanced diet?
- Science rocks and fossils, light and shadow (in caves), skeleton, teeth, muscles.
- Look at the monuments Stonehenge, Skara Brae. What is their significance?
- Music musical stones, creating instruments with natural materials, sound scapes.
- How do archaeologists investigate Stone Age life?
- MIX IT UP MIDDLE D and T day shelters and dens. Photography – manipulating photos.

RE DAYS

- We will be studying Christian artefacts, symbols, stained glass and the layout of a Christian church. We will investigate who the saints are and why they are important.
- We will investigate Hinduism and how God is worshipped in the home and Mandir. We will discuss the meaning of the story of Rama and Sita and how and why Diwali is celebrated.

BRONZE AGE

- Beaker people work and beliefs, make clay Beaker pots.
- Wales copper mines, mixing metals to develop stronger metals
- Bronze age settlements and communities.
- Social divide metal workers, tradesmen, leaders, farmers and peasants.
- Transport the wheel and horse drawn carriages.
- Early Celtic tribes where did they travel from? Their life, beliefs, trade and transport.

IRON AGE

- Investigate how iron overtook other metals strength, weapons and tools
- Changing British landscape hillforts, Maiden castle
- Farming and settlements
- D and T make model roundhouses
- Art sewing, making jewellery from natural twine, wool and beads
- Celts and arrival in Britain in Iron Age
- Study the discoveries of Clonycavan Man and Lindow Man
