SCIENCE

Plants! Observe plants from seed to flower. We will plant some seeds and do an experiment to see which conditions are best for growth.

We will compare and classify living things.

MUSIC

GEOGRAPHY

We will use simple compass directions and locational and directional language to describe the location of features and routes on a map. We will compare and use geographical similarities and differences. We will compare the human and physical geography of a small area of the United Kingdom, and of a small area in a contrasting non-European country.

ART & DT

Painting – look at the work of Claude Monet and Van Gogh that was inspired by nature. We will create our own landscape art by observing our own forest school.

To research and design a bridge using DT equipment – focus on the designs of bridges that help people navigate rainforests and dense woodlands

COOKING AND NUTRITION

We will inspect and analyse artefacts from the Hinduism and we will create a Rangoli pattern and understand its meaning.
