Project Planning - All About Me / We are Family

L.O. To be able to sort items that can and cannot be recycled. The children will investigate different packaging materials and why only some of these can be recycled.

A Recycling station will be created. What can and cannot be recycled? What will you make using recyclable materials?

Pebble Art: linking with our text, 'Only One You', the children will use old pebbles to upcycle and reuse for different purposes.

Children will continue to make their own products in the construction area using recyclable items.

L.O: To be able to use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination.

Children will plan, draw and colour their own self-portraits. This will link to their writing for this week, focussing on why we are all special and unique. (WC 12:9)

L.O. To know the changes within living memory — the seaside past and present.

This week, we will be launching the text 'All About Families'. Going to the seaside is enjoyed by many families, so we will investigate the changes that have occurred by the coast. (WC 19.9)

L.O. To understand significant historical events, people and places in their own locality.

The children will know who 'John Hellins' was and how/why he created the school.

Children will create their own family tree. (WC 26.9)
