

Maths	To be able to count in 2's	 Watch the video below to practise counting forwards to 20: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=GvTcpfSnOMQ Watch the video numerous times so you can remember all of the numbers, in order. Make some number cards for the 2 times tables to practise. Pick a card and try and say what comes next. When you're outside, get some objects from nature and organise them into groups of 2 and count them up and down. Complete the activity attached at the bottom of this document. You could print this, copy the drawings or count from the computer screen. To challenge yourself, create a sheet for counting in 5's or 10's!
	To show knowledge of place value with 2- and 3- digit numbers	 If you have some dice at home, roll it twice (to make a 2 digit number, or 3 times for a 3 digit number) Place the digits on a place value template (attached) and then practise adding 10 to them. You will find you need to change the tens column most of the time!
