ART



- If you draw a line from two wider points to two narrower points it creates a sense of perspective
- Colours such as red may increase the heart rate and anger/rage receptors, while colours such as a green and blue will have a much more calming effect.

SCIENCE

- Animals can be vertebrates or invertebrates
- Vertebrates have a spine, invertebrates do not
- Animals can be mammals, birds, fish, insects, reptiles and amphibians - categorised by their appearance and how they give birth
- The heart has four main parts - the left and right ventricle and the left and right atrium
- The heart is the organ that pumps the blood around the body
- Arteries take oxygenated blood away from the heart and the veins return it to start the process again
- The life cycle of a butterfly starts with an egg, which becomes a caterpillar, then a chrysalis and finally a butterfly
