SCIENCE

- Sound is caused by vibrations.

- Amplitude is how large a soundwave is and signifies how loud the sound will be.
- Pitch is a measure of how high or low a sound is.
- There are 3 states of matter: solid, liquid and gas.
- States of matter can change. For example, water can freeze to become solid.
- Water evaporates, condenses and falls as precipitation in the water cycle.

HISTORY

- The Vikings were invaders who travelled by sea and colonised countries throughout Europe between 793CE-1066CE.
- Dane Law was an area of England that was occupied by, and ruled by Vikings.
- Danegeld was a tax paid to the Vikings for protection against invasion.
- The Vikings and the Anglo-Saxons had many battles. Some key battles included; The battle of York, the battle of Englefield and the the battle of Edington.
- Life in Viking Britain was organised. There were Jarls (rich land owners), Karls (everyday people, like farmers) and Thralls (did the hardest and dirtiest jobs)

MUSIC

- Norse folk music has loud vocals, a consistent drum beat and legato, dynamic backing music.
