



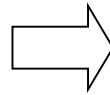
Project Planning - Castles and Monarchs.

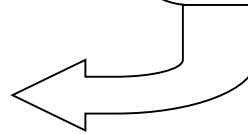
Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)

We will look at what the people who lived in the castle grew and where the water supply was.



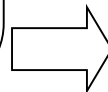
To describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

We will look at why it was important to eat healthily and keep clean. We will look at what facilities people had to keep clean in a castle.



To identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses.

We will be looking at the uses of wood and why arrows were made of wood.



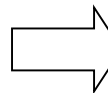
To observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. To find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

We will be looking at vegetables and how they're grown. We will be planting in our plot.
