



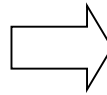
## Project Planning – Castles and Monarchs

### History

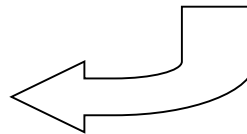
Saxon culture castles: kingdoms, farming, art and culture.

We will be looking at the early castles and the people's way of life, food and clothes.



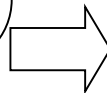
To study events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally e.g. The battle of Hastings 1066.

To study the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national achievements. To compare aspects of life in different periods.

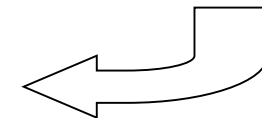
We will move on in time to around 1200 and compare the two. We will look at the Castles of 11<sup>th</sup> Century and compare the differences.
