



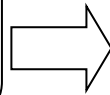

Science – To work scientifically by researching the gestation periods of other animals and compare them with humans.

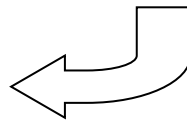
Art - To know different stitches.

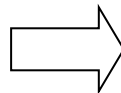

RE – To understand if it is necessary to believe in God to be a human. To understand how we know right from wrong. To understand what it means to be a person of faith in the 2020s.

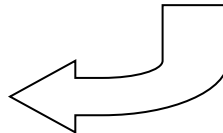
Computing – To know how to use technology safely, respectfully and responsibly. To know how to design, write and debug programs and solve problems.
