Reading and spellings

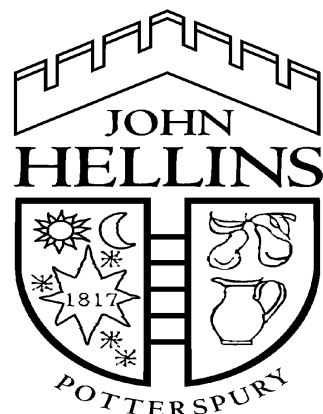
Franklin class can look forward to their first book a little later in the term. I have planned a brief meeting to explain how to support your child with reading and phonics at home. This will take place on **Friday 4th October**. Information about this meeting will be sent via email shortly. Practising reading and spelling is the most important form of homework for our youngest children as it provides the biggest impact on their future learning. Your support with this will be invaluable. In school, we shall read with the children fortnightly and we encourage them to change their books regularly by letting the adults know. We teach phonics daily alongside letter formation.

Project

We shall talk about coming to school, our birthdays, celebrate our families and look at other celebrations such as Diwali, fireworks night and Christmas. Following this theme, we will celebrate Autumn and the beautiful colour changes. This will link with animals and hibernation.
