



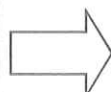
Project Planning – Spring 1

Lit – Biogs JH and other religious Leaders

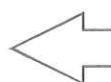


To understand the religion of India and surrounding areas.

Lit – Robinson Crusoe



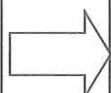
To understand the history of transport in the Georgian times – festival of transport.

Lit – newspaper, active and passive – first manned hot air balloon manned mission, hanging models for classroom.



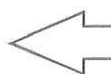
Test Week
