History

- *Thomas Edison was a famous scientist. Thomas is famous for inventing the first lightbulb that lasts a long time and for inventing the first microphone.*
- *Mary Seacole was a nurse from Jamaica. She helped injured soldiers in the Crimea War.*
- *Florence Nightingale was a nurse that helped injured soldiers in the Crimea War. Mary was a highly respected and recognised nurse, unlike Mary Seacole.*
- *Samuel Pepys wrote a famous diary. He was an eye-witness of the Great Fire of London.*
- *A diary is a primary source.*

- *An impression print can be created using polystyrene, pencil, printing ink and an ink roller.*
- *The process of printing is making a replica of what you have created.*
- *Multiple pieces of artwork can be created using the printing process.*
- *Digital Art refers to artistic work that uses digital technology.*
- *Photographs are a form of digital art.*
- *Cubism is an art movement that uses different perspectives of the same object.*
- *Pablo Picasso was a famous artist. He was born in Spain and lived in France. He died in Paris.*
- *Pablo Picasso was an artist that co-founded Cubism.*
