



KS2 Spelling Guidance

In Key Stage 2, spellings are taught as a whole class. Each week, the children will be exposed to a new spelling pattern where they will follow these steps:

- Reviewing the previous week/day's pattern
- Seeing, saying and writing the pattern
- Practising writing words with the pattern in
 - Writing a dictated sentence
 - Quiz

Teachers will be able to continually assess the children and their progress during these lessons, identifying and explicitly teaching misconceptions. There will continue to be no set weekly spelling lists. We would like you to enforce spellings at home by focusing on this term's patterns. If you would like any further advice, or have any questions about how we teach spellings in KS2, please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher.
