MATHS

Objectives to be covered this term:

- To know how to count from 1-10.
- To know how to continue a number sequence forwards and backwards..
- To know how to compare numbers.
- To count one more and one less.
- To know how to use the addition symbol to create number sentences for addition.
- To know how to solve missing number problems
- To know the names of 2D and 3D shapes
- To sort and group shapes based on their properties.

Things to help at home:

- Help your child to write numbers to 20 the correct way around.
- Practise recognising numbers to 20 knowing what each digit in the number is worth
- Practice addition and subtraction up to 20. For example, $4 + 12 =$
- Notice numbers in the environment, encouraging your child to read them.
- Look at 2D and 3D shapes in the shops in real life.

ENGLISH

Objectives to be covered this term:

Writing

- Use phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match their spoken sounds
- Write some irregular common words
- Write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others
- Spell some words correctly and others phonetically plausibly.

Reading

- Read and understand simple sentences
- Use phonic knowledge to sound out words and read them accurately
- Read some common irregular words
- Demonstrate understanding when talking with others about what they have read.

Speaking

- Express themselves effectively, showing awareness of listeners' needs
- Use past, present and future forms accurately when talking about events that have happened or are to happen in the future
- Develop own stories and explanations by connecting ideas or events.

Ways to help at home:

- Read with your child for at least 10 minutes every day and after reading, ask them comprehension questions about what they have read.
- Practice letter formation
- Retell stories
- Encourage independent writing/ reading at home.
- Writing sentences using correct punctuation, including full stops and capital letters.
