MATHS

Objectives to be covered this term:

- To represent numbers to 100 using a range of concrete materials such as beads, staws and base 10.
- To use a part whole model to explore how tens and ones can be partitioned.
- To present their work in the correct place value columns.
- To add and subtract number using concrete objects, pictorial representations and mentally, including:
 - A two-digit number add a one-digit number e.g. $21 + 6 =$
 - A two-digit number add 10s e.g. $37 + 10 =$
 - A two-digit number add a 2-digit number e.g. $45 + 23 =$
 - Three one-digit numbers e.g. $2 + 7 + 9 =$
- To recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p) and combine amounts to make a particular value.

Things to help at home:

Recognise and count numbers up to 100. You could make number cards, shuffle and say the number. Spot numbers on houses, buses, buildings etc. Use coins to create different amounts. Identify pound (£) and pence (p) symbols in shops to identify the value of products.

ENGLISH

Objectives to be covered this term:

Writing

- To be able to use familiar and new punctuation correctly, including capital letters, full stops, commas, question marks and exclamation marks.
- To be able to write sentences in different forms: statement, question and exclamation.
- To be able to write expanded noun phrases to describe.
- To be able to use spacing between words.
- To be able to write capital letters and digits of the correct size.

Reading

- To use phonics knowledge and skills to decode words.
- To be able to read accurately by blending sounds.
- To be able to read words containing suffixes.
- To be able to read most words accurately and fluently.
- To be able to read year 2 common exception words.

Things to help at home:

- Visit the school library or a local library.
- Practise writing sentences with capital letters and full stops.
- Practice writing letters of the correct size and formation.
