L.O. To develop a range of art and design techniques, using colour, pattern and texture. The children will be printing using bubble wrap.

To launch our story 'When Grandma Gives You a Lemon Tree', the children will make their own lemonade.

L.O. To be able to observe changes across the four seasons.

The children will be able to name the four seasons and use key vocabulary to identify the characteristics of each season.

L.O. To be able to create our own family tree.

To launch our story 'Five Minutes Peace', the children will understand why their family is so special and why we often celebrate with our family.

L.O. To be able to write a fact file.

The children will write sentences about elephants, focussing on full stops, capital letters and the formation of letters/digits.

L.O. To be able to listen to music with concentration and understanding.

L.O. To be able to use voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.

The children will listen to a range of lullabies in English. In link with our story 'Pattan's Pumkin', the children will listen to traditional lullabies from the South of India. We will sing, practise and perform one of these lullabies from India.

L.O. To be able to compare the UK to a non-European country.

The children will compare the village of Potterspurty to a village in India.

L.O. To be able to name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans.

The children will label these using a map. They will identify where India is located.
