



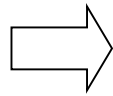
Project Planning – It's a Celebration!

The children will make a diva lamp using clay.

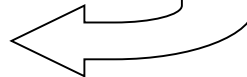


To launch our text 'We're going on a Leaf Hunt', the children will be able to identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

The children will learn about Vincent Van Gogh and his love of painting nature. The children will write a fact file about him and take part in leaf printing.

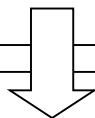
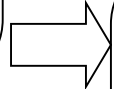


To launch our story 'Winter Sleep', the children will be able to identify and name common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
